We want to see your best moments from on-site and out in the field. This is a great chance to share your view of what we do and have a bit of fun. We're looking for photos in all categories:

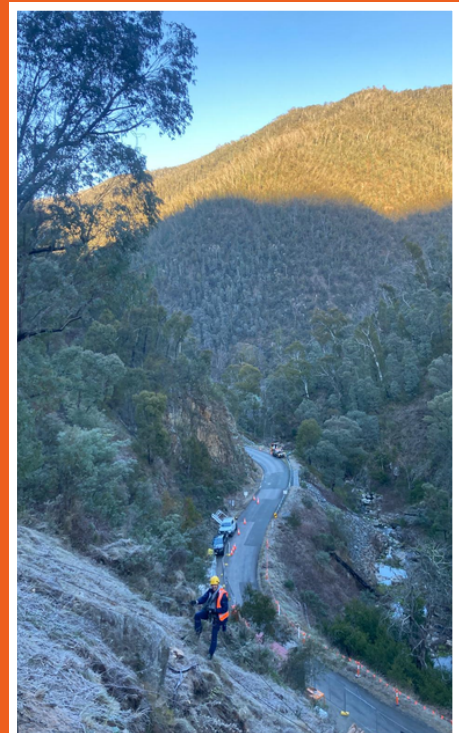

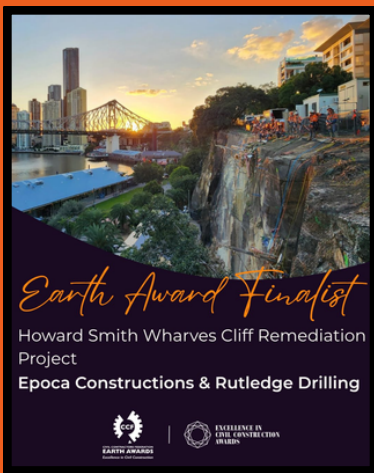
Employee of the Month
