LINE OF FIRE AWARENESS

Being in the “line of fire” means putting yourself in the path of moving equipment, falling objects, or stored energy.

Stay Clear: Keep clear of moving plant, suspended loads, and swinging tools.

Position Yourself Safely: Never place hands, feet, or body parts where they could be caught, crushed, or struck.

Stay Alert: Make eye contact with operators and never assume they can see you.

The Risk: One wrong position can result in serious injury.

Remember: If you can't see an escape path, you're too close.

Our annual Christmas Party was the perfect way to wrap up another successful year - filled with great food, laughter, and a friendly game of lawn bowls! 🎉

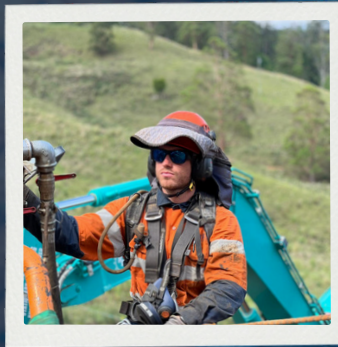
